
Adding

License handling: Editing a pattern

- ▶ A pattern can be published under a restrictive license
- ▶ Only authenticated user can choose a restrictive license
- ▶ Editing differs whether the editor is the author or not
- ▶ If editing is not allowed for a pattern, the user has to write a new description, which will be added as a new version.





Community




Document Design Decisions
